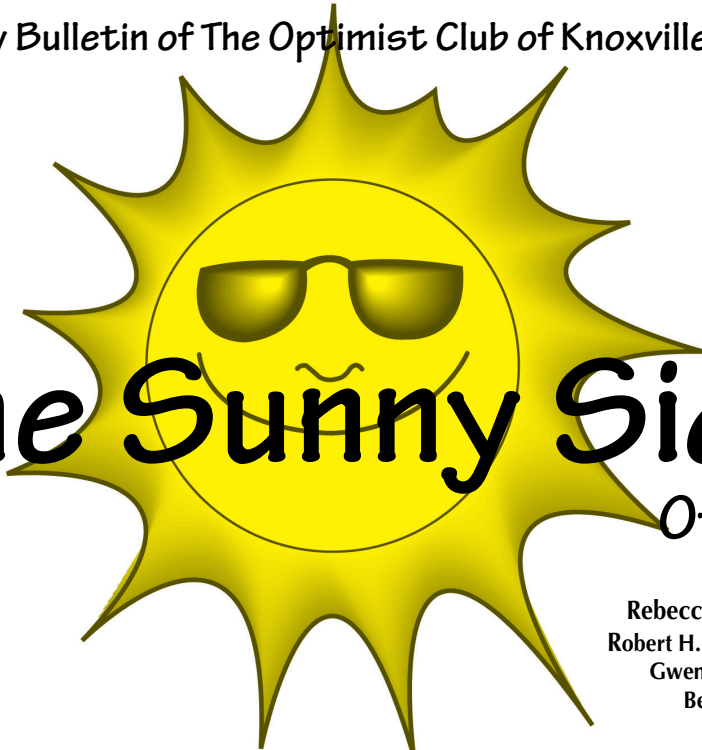

The Market Square Farmers' Market was started on Market Square in 2004 and grew to be one of the top producer-only farmers' markets in the country. As the market grew, it became apparent that there was no non-profit working on food issues in the Knoxville area. Market director CHARLOTTE TOLLEY convened a group of local-food loving people to become the first board of directors, and they created Nourish Knoxville to take on projects in the Knoxville food shed beyond the farmers' markets.
